- 6. The language or languages spoken there

Option 2: Your Summer in Review

Keep track of places you go this summer (either around the city or on a trip) and make a poster, collage, bag or box to show what you did and saw.

You should include:

- 1. Where you went (neighborhoods / city / state)
- 2. What you did there
- 3. Who you saw

- 4. A description of the weather
- 5. Places/activities you would recommend to someone visiting that place
- 6. Some of the things you ate

Include a variety of images & descriptive language related to your location.
